Shonan iPark Signs Partnership Agreement with UK Science Ecosystem, via the National Horizons Centre

MOU to Expand and Strengthen Shonan iPark's UK-Japan Life Science Innovation Network

Shonan Health Innovation Park ("Shonan iPark") today announced that it has entered into a memorandum of understanding ("MOU") to establish partnership agreement with the National Horizons Centre ("NHC"), which sits at the heart of a bioscience cluster in the northeast of England from March 15th. Under the MOU, Shonan iPark and the NHC will combine efforts to organize joint initiatives, including training programs and opportunities to share knowledge and exchange ideas, to achieve their shared goal of realizing life science innovation.

NHC is a £22.3 million state-of-the-art investment, located on Darlington Central Park, in the UK, specializing in biosciences. With research, partnerships, and training at its core, the NHC brings together industry, academia, talent and world-class facilities to create real-world impact, discovering diseases earlier, developing novel treatments and delivering life-saving medicines quicker, safer and more affordably. With specialisms in disease-specific research, biomanufacturing and digital analytics and machine learning, the NHC works in an agile way to advance biosciences and healthcare research.

Darlington Central Park is also home to the Northern Bio-Accelerator Partnership. between NHC, FUJIFILM Diosynth Biotechnologies, and CPI, which is a founding member of the UK government's 'High Value Manufacturing Catapult' innovation initiative. The partnership serves as a hub for bioprocessing, biomanufacturing, and biopharmaceuticals in the UK's northeast regions, forming a center of innovation in the area.

The collaboration between NHC and Shonan iPark covered in this MOU includes:

- Joint initiatives to develop talent in both organizations (tailor-made training programs, talent referrals, and Shonan iPark member visits to the UK's northeast when international travel is permitted).
- Sharing of research themes and acceleration of joint research.
- Co-sponsorship of seminars for sharing academic expert knowledge.

"We are delighted to be able to work with members of Shonan iPark", says Dr Jen Vanderhoven,

Director of NHC. "Both organizations have developed vibrant ecosystems and undertaken activities to

fill the gap between academic research and commercialization. It will be an excellent opportunity to

connect Tees Valley with Japan based on such common values and jointly explore new ways to develop

and deliver innovative technologies in biosciences and healthcare."

Dr. Toshio Fujimoto, General Manager of Shonan iPark says "I believe this partnership between the two

science-based innovation centers will enable further sharing of knowledge and collaboration

opportunities for researchers at both sites. It will be a privilege if together this agreement paves the

way for bringing innovation communities in the UK and Japan closer."

This will be the fourth partnership for Shonan iPark, which actively seeks collaboration with overseas

ecosystems to accelerate innovation in life sciences. Shonan iPark will continue efforts to network with

leading ecosystems around the world to develop a global life sciences ecosystem that serves to

implement innovative ideas in society.
